HOPE HOUSE



At the end of the first quarter of the year, the shelter had sixteen (16) teenagers, one (1) child, one (1) adult. Bringing the total number to eighteen (18) clients. Seven (7) new clients were admitted into the shelter

on accounts of sexual assault and domestic violence, while six (6) clients were released which includes reconciliation with their family and transfer to other NGOs.

In the areas of academics, home schooling and vocational training were continued for clients that have not been registered in schools.

There has been more quantitative and qualitative counseling which is currently been offered by Dr. Gbonju Abiri, a Consultant Psychiatrist.

Extra Activities



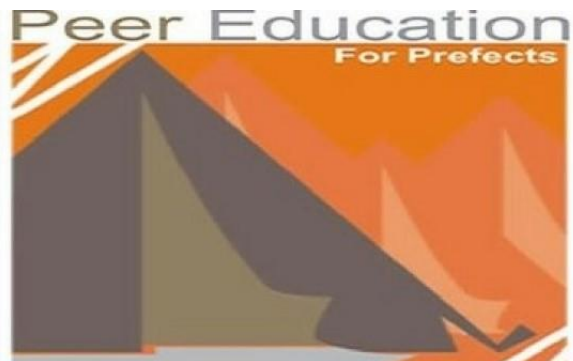
Vocational training was done free of charge by Zoya Jewels. The clients were taught how to make bead. The vocational training was done during the Easter period.

PEER EDUCATION FOR PREFECTS (PEP)/GIRLS EMPOWERED

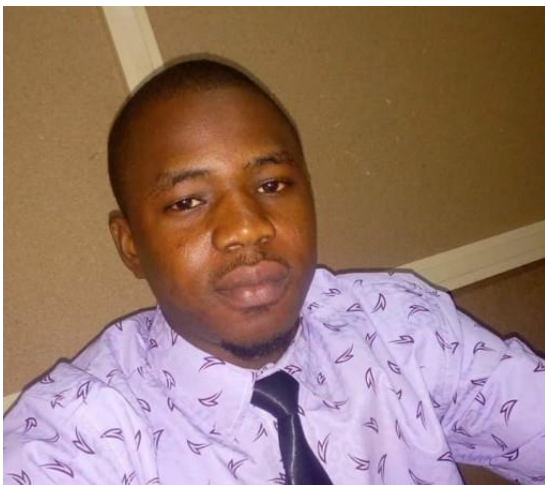
