First Quarter Report 2019

Happy new month, Thank you for your support in the first quarter of 2019.

Achievements and Activities

The foundation's administrative new office is at 12, Industrial Estate Ilupeju, Lagos.

School fees and back to school supplies were provided for twelve (12) ex-clients, WAEC/NECO for three (3) ex-clients, JAMB for one (1) ex-client, JSCE for two (2) ex-clients, and WAEC/NECO camping fee for one (1) ex-client.

The foundation handled thirteen (13) domestic violence cases, twelve (12) online counseling and thirty five (35) teen counseling.



Hope House shelter was shutdown and all the properties were transferred to Grace Springs Rehabilitation Home, Echoes of Mercy and Hope Foundation (EMHF), Livingstone College Ikorodu and Ministry of Youth and Social development (MYSO).

There was post rehabilitation counseling and follow up visits of ex-clients.

Sweet Sensation visited and donated foodstuffs and toiletries as part of their CSR. The items were given to ex-clients and Echoes of Mercy and Hope Foundation.



Ministry of Education gave the foundation approval to host 1000 girls on Friday 11th October, 2019.
